What is Starpoint?

Starpoint is a special conference organized for youth by youth. It is held every other year, in a different location each time. The first festival was held at Bodajk in 2003.

During Starpoint, more than 2,500 young people come together in community to share and discuss the event's theme. In addition to having fun and enjoying cultural activities, committed Christians and seekers are able to meet and share their thoughts about the world, common or differing values and God. The event is organized and run by close to 500 volunteers. It is their hard work that makes this event possible.

2013 Festival Theme – Identity

The upcoming Starpoint will focus on the concept of identity. Young people receive pressure from a variety of places in the virtual world. Can they identify themselves among this myriad of influences? If so, how do they navigate and find their way? The question we will explore is "Who am I?" In other words, what do I think of myself, what do others think of me and what is God's vision for me? These are universal questions, relevant to everyone, that must not be ignored.





Where is it located?

The location is different for every Starpoint event. The festival shakes up not just Hungary, but the whole Carpathian Basin. The constantly changing location allows all presbytery districts an opportunity to host the event and allows all neighboring Hungarian communities the chance to send large numbers of youth to join.

Who is it for?

The event is open to young people between the ages of 16 and 30, who attend reformed churches or who would like to discover (or rediscover) their Christian roots, and for all those who are simply interested in discovering why reformed Christianity is relevant and cool.
